4. REGISTERING FOR COMPETITION

- 4.1. Upon pre-registration, the participation applications shall be submitted via the website choosing the competition from the list that the person wishes to register for. (Link: www.balticracingseries.eu)
- 4.2. Pre-registration shall be opened as from 1st July and it shall be closed on 17th of August 2026 at 24:00 local time. Late registration is possible during the Competition in accordance with the timetable.
- 4.3. A Competitor has pre-registered if, by the term provided in clause 4.2., they have complied with the following conditions:
 - a) The Competitor has submitted the registration application specified in clause 4.1.;
 - b) The entry charges for the competition have been paid either to the bank account specified in clause 5.3., or in cash at the secretariat of the Competition. The burden of proof with regards to proving compliance with the term of paying the entry charges lies with the Competitor. Any and all expenses related to paying the entry charges shall be borne by the Competitor.
- 4.4. Following the closing of the pre-registration, registering for the competitions shall be possible at the secretariat of the Competition pursuant to time table of the Competition.
- 4.5. By submitting a participation application, the Competitor represents and warrants that:
 - ☒ it undertakes to comply with the rules and regulations of the Competition;
 - ☒ the competing vehicle corresponds to the technical conditions and requirements of the respective class;
 - ☒ the Competitor shall be liable for the loss of or damage to the timing transponder;
 - ☒ the Competitor understands that participating in motorsports competitions poses a hazard for their life and health as well as the equipment to be used but nevertheless agrees to participate in the competitions at their own liability. The Organizer, the team members of the Organizer, the track owner and the team members of the track owner shall not be liable for any possible accidents and the consequences thereof. The Competitor shall discharge the aforesaid people from any liability;
 - ☒ the Competitor is in good health, in accordance with the conclusion of the doctor, is allowed to do racing but in spite of that undertakes to have an appropriate and valid health insurance policy which might be necessary in case of accident during Competition;

5. ENTRY FEES

- 5.1. In order to be permitted to participate in the Competition, Competitor must pay a participation Entry Fee in favor of the Organizer of the Competition.

- 5.4. The Organizer has the right to invite special VIP Competitors and participants free of charge.
- 5.5. If a Competitor is excluded from the Competition by a decision of the Race Directors, the paid entry charges shall not be refunded.

- 5.6. If a pre-registered Competitor notifies the Organizer of non-participation in the Competition before the end of the pre-registration term in a format that can be reproduced in writing, 50% of the paid entry charges will be refunded.

6. ADVERTISING AND AUDIO-VISUAL MATERIALS

- 6.1. The Layout of the compulsory advertising stickers on the racing cars (if any) will be published as the Bulletin not later than 20.08.2026, otherwise, conditions of the actual Sporting Regulations of the respective racing series and classes to apply.

7. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

- 7.1. For the BaTCC, NEA, HEC and/or BaTA racing series, the process of submitting a protest and/or appeal as well as the handling the same are processed in accordance with the conditions in paragraph #9 of the sporting regulations.
- 7.2. For the MB, FH and WSMP racing series, the process of submitting and handling a protest and/or appeal will be carried out in accordance with the FIA Code, Article 13 (Protests), Article 15.4 (Appeals), and Article 16 of the FH General Sporting Regulations. The sporting protest deposit is EUR 300.-, and the technical protest deposit is EUR 1000.-

8. AWARD CEREMONY

- 8.1. The award ceremony shall take place in accordance with the official timetable of the Competition based on the preliminary results.
- 8.2. The award ceremony is compulsory for the winners of each class to participate in the ceremony.
- 8.3. Wearing the racing suit during the award ceremony shall be mandatory. Upon not wearing the racing suit or being absent from the award ceremony, a fine of EUR 100,- shall be imposed on the Competitor.
- 8.4. The number of winners obliged to participate in the award ceremony and agenda of the ceremony will be announced during the drivers briefing.

9. PASSES

- 9.1. All people present in the territory of the track of the Competition must carry valid passes issued by the Organizer.
- 9.2. Parking passes entitles to park a vehicle in the parking lot indicated therein. Filled in parking pass must be affixed to the windshield. Each team may have max 2 service vehicles in the Paddock.
- 9.3. Damaged passes can be exchanged in the Secretariat of the Competition.
- 9.4. When registering for the Competition, Competitors of NEA and HEC will receive the following number of passes:
- ☒ Drivers – 2 passes (for access to the Paddock);
 - ☒ Mechanics – 6 passes (for access to the Paddock);
 - ☒ Service vehicles – 2 passes (for access to the Paddock).
- 9.5. When registering for the Competition, Competitors of all other racing series will receive the following number of passes:
- ☒ Drivers – 1 pass (for access to the Paddock);
 - ☒ Mechanics – 3 passes (for access to the Paddock);
 - ☒ Service vehicles – 2 passes (for access to the Paddock).
- 9.6. Additional, free of charge passes for Competitors of NEA or HEC will not be provided to Competitors registered also in BaTCC, BaTA or FH and vice versa.
- 9.7. Upon request of the Competitor additional passes for access to the Paddock can be purchased. The price of one pass is EUR 10,-. Each competitor is allowed to purchase limited number of passes, providing maximum 10 passes per Competitor in total.

10. OTHER CONDITIONS
